Chicago Police Recover Multiple Guns during Execution of Search Warrant on the City's South Side

CHICAGO – The Chicago Police Department's Area Two Gun Team executed a search warrant Friday evening at a home on the 6100 block of S. Indiana that resulted in two arrests and the recovery of 5 firearms.

One offender, Lloyd Turentine, 28, of the 2000 block of W. Prentiss Dr. in Downers Grove, Illinois, was taken into custody and charged with 1 count of Unlawful Use of Weapon-Aggravated/Vehicle Concealed and was cited for Unlawful Possession of unregistered Firearms. A second offender, Misty Woodrick, 29, of Chicago was also cited for Unlawful Possession of unregistered Firearms.

Area Two personnel received information regarding Turentine and the target location and were able to obtain a search warrant. Officers executed the warrant, and a systematic search of the residence and a vehicle netted three assault rifles and two semi-automatic handguns, along with magazine clips and ammunition of various calibers. Both offenders were subsequently taken into custody without incident and charged accordingly.

Due to the officers' keen observations and efforts, they were able to locate and remove these dangerous weapons before they made their way to our city streets.

Both offenders are scheduled to appear in bond court later today.
